## 1 Design a poster

Poster for a Shakespeare production by your school or any theatre group

It must include: the name of the play and all performance details eg time, date, performed by, ticket prices, where to book, venue. These must be clearly visible

## 2 Present on A3 or A4 paper or light card and send in an appropriate size envelope folder or tube.

## 3 Write an accompanying rationale of approximately 400 words describing:

- a brief outline of the style in which the play is being performed
- why you are using the reflected style in your poster
- the target audience to whom you are directing the design

Entrants must be a Friend of SGCNZ either through their school, home school cluster OR community groups, OR individually
